The applicant is requested to complete this form as fully as possible. The information will be handled confidentially. Essay questions should be answered on separate paper. NOTE: All applications and supporting documentation must be postmarked by **January 19, 2010**.

Following review of applications, semi-finalists are chosen by March. Semi-finalists are asked to come for an in-person interview, after which time the new class of Fellows is selected and announced, usually by the end of April.

Prospective applicants should make sure their references can speak to the strength of the candidate for fulfilling the mission of the John Wesley Fellows as well as the strength of their academic ability.

Essays and materials should also indicate an understanding of the mission of the Fellows, an emerging understanding of how they will contribute to the needs of the church and her institutions and the formation of students. Candidates are encouraged to talk with current Fellows to gain a better understanding of AFTE. While it does provide scholarship support, it is much more than a scholarship program. It seeks to be an ongoing fellowship of scholars and leaders.

2. What are the principal issues, leading scholars, and primary schools of thought in your proposed field of study? What draws you to this field of study, and what contribution do you hope to make to this field?
3. Outline and briefly discuss the Wesleyan distinctives that you regard as especially important. How are they relevant to current theological issues, trends, etc.?
4. Describe your feelings about and your present involvement in the United Methodist Church (local and otherwise). How do you intend to use your gifts, graces, and academic expertise to witness for Christ and enrich the Church?
5. Write your spiritual autobiography, including your present areas of growth and struggle.
